The key theme that came up was that housing was being built without a focus on the associated infrastructure needed to support it. Mostly people wanted places to socialise (including for young people), followed by concerns about health and dentistry services overwhelmed already before population growth.

TRAFFIC, SPEEDING AND ANTI-SOCIAL PARKING



Residents expressed concern about pavement parking, not enough parking and developments exacerbating parking problems. Also concerns about speeding making Lockleaze unsafe for pedestrians

CONCERN FOR GREEN SPACE

Many of the residents expressed concern about developments resulting in loss of green space (Bonnington, Dovercourt) with issues ranging from loss of places to play and walk, loss of trees and impact on nature.
